Structure

the party has two main chambers organized as permanent assembly with different levels (units).

- Assembly of Representatives:
it has functions of organization, direction and executive coordination.
The units will have functional Areas.
- Assembly of Pirates:
it has programmatic functions and proposals.
The units will have thematic Areas.

Each chamber is organized in “onion” units in order to manage different level of inclusivity in Euro Areas

In both chambers, members will be able to discuss and vote basing on their country position.

Membership

The assembly of Representatives are nominated by the respective country pirate parties.

The number of representatives per country is calculated as follows: square root population* divided by 100.

They are elected each year

The assembly of Pirates will have all individuals of europe that want to join even if they are not already members of their country/region pirate party, as well they accept the statute, programme and regulation of PP-EU.
