For an asynchronous working plateform

For an asynchronous working plateform

Reasoning: :

For a year now, several pirates active at the European level have been questioning the development of asynchronous work within the party. This mainly concerns debates on substantive issues that are sometimes difficult to deal with only through meetings.

While the introduction of Mattermost has been a great step forward in creating a more accessible working environment, the immediacy of discussions and the speed of exchanges can make information difficult to access.

Today, the PPEU does not have a platform for asynchronous work. If mailing lists exist, they can make it very difficult to work collectively and require multiple registrations. A unique transparent platform can only strengthen the involvement of pirates at the European level.

Many of us are volunteers and it can be difficult to find meeting times that are accessible to all, just as it is understandable that our European elected officials and their teams are not necessarily available in the evening after their work day. An asynchronous discussion platform will allow to create a space of exchange where everyone will be able to intervene when they are available, a space where information can be transmitted efficiently without the risk of being lost in a conversation.

It could also be interesting to integrate the possibility of making decisions asynchronously through this platform.

The present motion gives a mandate to the board to study the possibility of setting up an asynchronous discussion platform after having defined the specifications in association with the party members.

This being stated:

<u>Motion:</u>

In consideration of Article 5 of Statutes in particular its paragraph a), d), e) ;

In consideration of the importance of facilitating the work of pirates at the European level and allowing everyone to participate;

Article 1: The Board is responsible for drawing up specifications for the establishment of an asynchronous discussion and decision-making platform in consultation with the party members.

Article 2: Once the specifications have been established, the Bureau will draw up a list of applications that it will submit to the Council so that the latter can choose the platform to be set up.

The Board will have to present its list for the next Council meeting.
