B. Each Delegate shall introduce the position of their PP and why they want to be part of what kind of PPEU (2 minutes max. each)

- BE
 - We don't want another PPI, we are small party. We expect concrete thing, sharing ideas, doing everything together for the campaign, a european pirate tour, an special FB just for Pirates. We don't want powerful people, we want to work together.
- CAT
 - The catalonians and catalonian party are all for Europe, it will be very good as advertisement for the elections to have a platform in Europe to show to public that we are working together. It would be important for us if we can make collective decisions. And we want to keep the structure very simple
- DE
 - A lot like Muriel have said, Germans are very pro -Europe and it's really important the feeling of being part of a bigger movement. We are hoping to join the Pirate parties of different countries together, not only a national force but a european force. We also hope to get more funds for election campaigns, and to work towards getting support for actions that are also European policies.
- FR
 - We are pro Europe, to have a place to share a common program but we want to have a structure, not an empty party to collect funds from the EU. We will also want to build something that means we can share ideas mostly on international/european topics (ie patents), somewhere we can discuss these ideas and build the European pirate idea.
- GR
 - It's the first time that Greece has an official delegate here (applause!). Unfortunately we don't have as many resources, we definitely are EU oriented party, we want something meaningful for the european elections
- HR
 - We are a small party, becoming EU member first of july. We don't want PPEU to become another PPI, we will be able to have shared resources, not just money, ideas, solutions etc. The general oppinion in Croatia is that we wont have any benefits from entering EU but the PP of Croatia is certainly pro-EU.
- NL
 - I didn't have enough time to talk about the subject with Samir so, all I can say is that I'm certain that they dont want another organization like PPI. For everything else, it would only be fair to let Samir to talk about.
- IT
 - Two new coordinators elected: Jaromil is is here for the first time and Alvisse the other delegate is remote. Daniele and Luciana can not come, they are remote on mumble.
 - The Italian PP is pro europe, but this still needs an internal discussion in detail for which a workgroup is forming: we made a new team of approx 60 people to take care of the 2014 european elections and yes we are definitely pro europe.
 - Migration policies are high on the PP-IT agenda
 - Euroliquid: our assembly has decided to open up the euroliquid process, the range of delegates or even having a direct voting.
- PT
 - First time as well for Nuno Cardoso: our resources are stretched and we are also very pro europe. We see this as the platform to support pirates in European Parliament, since the EP changes the law. We don't want the PPEU to impose a program into the parties, PPEU is the common ground and the things we agree. We want a tool to make the members to be the ones deciding in PPEU, a bigger involvement to make it functional and not only boards and conferences.
- SE
 - We disagree with most of you, we want a minimal organization that we can take the euro

funding, but no common program, just a few people deciding things. Maximum power for a little group and minimum power for decision. Intellectual copyright reform, champion privacy and advocate democracy, nothing else.

E. Euroliquid

Jaromil: Permanent assembly: There are groups working constantly, there is a delegation process that it's mainly about experts. It works really well for us.

We want to propose a group that could use Liquid Feedback in the process of the creation of PP Europe. Used only by the delegations who have been following the discussions.

Mab: We agreed to see if there could be a working tool for Liquid feedback in Potsdam but that was 8 months ago and there is no working result. We shouldn't have to give the green light in every conference.

The Manifesto will include then consensual principles that we could all agree with, like

- * Citizen participation
- * Transparency
- * Civil/human rights (including privacy, freedom of speech and net neutrality)
- * Open Data
- * Open Government
- * Free/libre culture (including Free/libre software)
- * Open Access
- * Copyright reform
- * Patent system reform

Send this list to the European pirate parties to see if any of these points would be a red line. The results shall be ready by the end of April and they should be send to Mattias. Silence is positive.
